What is the Wai'anae Watershed Management Plan? (WWMP)

The WWMP is one of eight district plans prepared by the City & County of Honolulu Board of Water Supply (BWS) and the Department of Planning and Permitting (DPP). Together, the eight plans comprise the O'ahu Water Management Plan. The WWMP is intended to be an environmentally holistic, community-based, and economically viable watershed management plan that is action oriented and incorporates ahupua'a-based management principles. The plan will identify key water resource issues and recommend policies, strategies, and projects to ensure adequate and sustainable water supply for Wai'anae for the next twenty years.
